This un-foretold event brought havoc in each person's life style and financially disrupted many households. Schools were also hard hit as schools remained closed in the wake of spread of the pandemic and for protection of young ones. Little had anyone idea about the virtual mode of education and same emerged as a great help for teachers and schools to continue imparting education to the students in such difficult times where students could not attend the school. Noel School App, Google Meet, Google Classroom, Learning Management System, etc. have proved very useful for the blended teaching learning process. We ensured to switch to the new arrangement from 15th May, 2020 for Higher Classes and the blended teaching learning process began from then. Teachers also learnt the new apps and operating them

and understanding meticulous functions was a huge challenge especially for teachers who had very basic knowledge of smart phones. Yet our determined teachers and the management quickly shifted to the virtual classrooms and left no stone unturned to explore the possibilities to enable most of the activities performed in a normal session virtually possible. May it be daily teaching, Home assignments, Skill evaluation, tests, exams, competitions or Annual Celebration, almost all activities were conducted with prior planning. In difficult times of COVID-19 the school ensured that not a single child is deprived from getting education. We thank all the parents for being so supportive to school by supervising the students at home and arranging resources as and when required by the students. Without parent's support the virtual education would not have been possible.

This pandemic has turned our teachers into techno-teachers as they are now trained and equipped to handle virtual mode and blended mode

of classroom and have learnt many tools and options which otherwise could never be explored. Teachers' contribution can never be underestimated as their sincere efforts and patience have borne fruits and as a result around 95% of the students have been successful in completing the virtual mode of education despite issues of poor connectivity in many areas and other issues. The learning gap was hence minimal due to the arrangements made by the school considering various conditions.



Let's find new opportunities in difficulties and that's the way life goes on...






Online Teaching started for Students of NOEL SCHOOL, AKOLA CBSE Class 8 to 10 from 15th of May, 2020.

Online Interactive Classes start for Students of CBSE Class 1 to 7

The students were also asked to follow the instructions sent to them earlier. Usually the school for Class 1 to 7 begins from 15th June every year, but to help students and teachers become friendly to online platform and to brush up the basic skills, the school arranged the online interactive classes right from 1st of June, 2020. Here the teachers conducted live lectures and students were present for the first time virtually to attend their school and hear their teachers live. A tentative time-table has been prepared just for this situation and most of the students have attended these classes. Also the school has introduced LMS (Learning Management System) for the students of Class 1 to 10 through School's App to enable students and teachers complete their study and assignments according to their pace.


Virtual Annual Celebration 2020-2021














Unveiling of Biographical Book - Abhalmaya Date: 08-04-2021

His singing and dancing for the kids and his – 'Hello Everyone!' still resounds in our hearts as we remember his gestures of warm welcome and hand shake at the school's gate and his kisses of kids irrespective of their nature is something magical and unprecedented character which one will think only exists in fictional work. Vijay Manwar Sir as the Founder of Noel School, Akola who was a great philanthropist and known for his Coaching Class – NIPPLE Classes for English and later also for Noel School, Akola. 



Founder Principal Neel School, Akola

School's Founder

Lives of Great Men all remind us, We can make our lives sublime, And departing, leave behind us, Footprints on the Sands of Time. - H.W. Longfellow Rev. Father Vijay Lawrence Manwar, the pioneer of English Speaking Classes viz. NIPPLE CLASSES in Akola and the Founder Principal of Noel School, Akola was a humanitarian par excellence, a perfect paragon of patience and hard work and a personification of enthusiasm and selfless service. Being a priest by profession, he came to Akola in 1976 after being transferred from Nagpur as a Priest-in-charge of the All Saints' Church, CNI, Akola situated in front of Janata Bazar. It was in this Church

compound that he conceptualized and realized NIPPLE CLASSES that catered to the dire need of thousands of students and professionals for English Speaking with great perseverance and hard work. On the earnest recommendations of the massive student fraternity of the class took birth another institution, NOEL SCHOOL in 1992 with the admission of just three pupils. However nothing could deter the spirit of Sir and in March 2005 this batch of 26 students completed Matriculation making Sir's Dream come true. He was an egalitarian thinker and a strict disciplinarian living by the axiom 'Simple Living and High Thinking' nurturing the school's motto-'Arise and Shine in Service to Mankind'. He was seen welcoming every student right at the Gate with his cheerful and warm handshake to help students begin their day cheerfully. He was a teacher who not only dreamed but also taught his students to dream and realize their dreams by overcoming every obstacle with courage and great fortitude without losing enthusiasm. He widened the horizons of his students as well as teachers with his inspiring oratory skills. He won the hearts of millions of parents because of his humble nature. He made many reforms in the school's education policy. He also catered to the urgent need of Basic Grammar of English and himself conducted Workshops for Noel Staff and students for enhancing their communication skills and personality development. 
