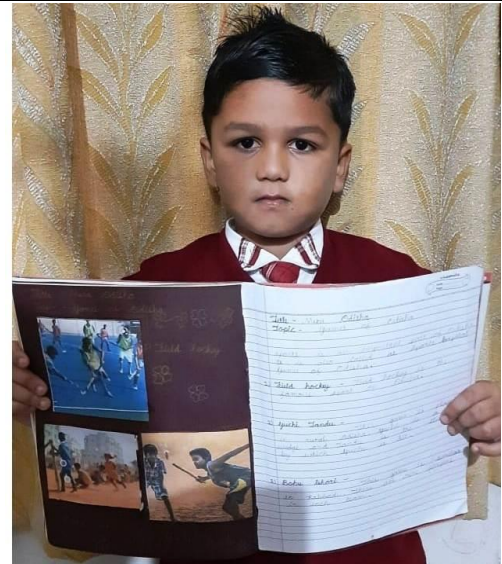

Games of Odisha

1) Bagaichi Khela - It is a game played by boys and men during Raja Parba. It is the Odia version of Kabaddi. Indigenous sports competition organized to celebrate Raja Mahotsav.

2) Gucha Buchi and Gasa Buchi - Buchi is one of the favorite sports of young girls since time immemorial. It is traditionally played by girls during Kumara Pushtima and Raja Parba also.

3) Bati / Marbles - It is also called Kancha, which means glass marbles which are readily available in the rural shops too. Kids make different groups and strike as many bati of the opponent group.

4) Guchi Tandul - In this game, Guchi is known to be a wooden wedge chambered on both faces and Tandul is the stickon by which the Guchi is hit.
