This evaluation consists of marks scored by students in all the activities, projects, school programmes and written assessments in the whole year. Parents need to pay special attention towards the writing skills as the CBSE Board has gradual increase in the portion for final exam class wise eventually having 100% syllabus for Class 9 and Class 10. We also look forward to implement the changes as and when CBSE provides the guidelines as per NEP.

And more stars be born out of sheer hardwork and perseverance by self enlightenment and also with the help of good parental support and monitoring measures. TEXTBOOKS AND STATIONERY :

All the textbooks and notebooks & stationery items will be available at 'BOOKS CORNER', Old Income Tax square, Gourakshan Road, AKOLA. Ph. 9673779902. Old & used textbooks are not allowed as it has negative impact on studies and learning pattern. <u>Textbooks will be available in only complete set and loose books will not be provided.</u> It is not compulsory to purchase the textbooks from the above shop. UNIFORM:

The uniform for CBSE students will be available at "ANIKO SALES", near Four Bunglows, Gaurakshan Road, Akola Mob. 9960050367. Blazer (Winter uniform) will be compulsory for all students. Any change in the design and colour will not be acceptable.

SCHOOL FEES:

The school fees will have to be paid in three installments. Installment 1 by 15th April, 2024, Installment 2 by 15th June, 2024 and Installment 3 by 15th October,2024. For the fees of Session 2024-2025 please refer the backside. Parents can pay the school fees online through school's app or by CASH in school Office. Parents may also pay the complete fee(all 3 installments) in the starting of the session if they wish to do so. Late fee of Rs. 10/- per day will be charged after these dates. Late fee of Rs.100/- per day will be charged from 1st of April, 2024. Each installment must be paid before the respective exam otherwise exams will not be conducted for your ward.

SCHOOL DISCIPLINE :

It will be obligatory for every child studying in CBSE School to speak in English only. The failure to which will invite a fine of Rs. 100/- per instance. Students in CBSE School must not indulge in any wrong things, failure to which will invite strict disciplinary actions from school. Parents also have to maintain supportive and conducive atmosphere and proper discipline at home. The child is required to read the textbooks and do self-study. Parents should supervise the reading and self-study time every day. Private tuition of any CBSE student is strictly forbidden. Parents must meet the teachers regularly to understand different problems of their child. Hence parents must not blindly believe the things reported by students, instead inform or enquire from teachers. Parents must register/update their mobile number/address and download Noel School app to get regular notifications from school and for security purpose. Parents must download 'Noel School App' from Google Play Store compulsorily to keep themselves updated with school messages and communication. The school will not be responsible in any way for any consequences, if the parents do not remain in contact will school through this school app communication medium. Parents are also requested to dress decently while visiting school or office. No night suits/gowns, pyjamas, shorts etc. will be allowed. Only formal dress will be expected to get entry in school premises.

Fee Payment Schedule

The Annual School Fees has to be paid in three installments as follows:

(Class 1 to Class 10)

First Installment : Before 15th April, 2024
Second Installment : Before 15th June, 2024
Third Installment : Before 15th October, 2024

Late Fee : Rs. 10/- per day for installments separately after these dates

and Rs.100/- per day after 01-04-2025

<u>Parents can pay the school fees online through school's app or by CASH in school office.</u> Fees once paid will not be refundable in mid-session due to transfer or any other reason.

School Diary & Meeting Teachers: The Noel School 'Diary' is an effective means of communicating with parents on daily-weekly basis. If parents fail to see the Diary, especially the teacher's remarks, they would fail to monitor the child's progress. Similarly, teachers call the parents to visit school (at least three to four times in a session) by issuing 'VISIT PASS' to students. If parents see the Diary and meet the teachers regularly and give their feedback through proper interaction, we can together focus our attention on the areas of concern to help the child achieve higher academic excellence. However, all this has to be done keeping in mind the time schedule of school so that it does not affect our teaching process.

Transfer Certificate (T.C.): T.C. will be issued after 3 days (minimum) from receiving the application duly approved by the Principal. It is also subject to clearance of all fees, dues and fines and receipt of Library books. Please mention your child's full name, Class and Section and your Mobile number on the application. If parent applies for T.C. in the month of April or later, the fees up to that month will be charged.

Regular Admissions: Children studying in **U.K.G.** have to take admission in Primary School Class 1 and children studying in **Class 8** have to take admission in High School Class 9 due to change of school for the next year. The process of CBSE Class 1 and CBSE Class 9 Regular Admissions is finalized.

Last Date of Admission was: For CBSE Class 1: 20-01-2024 & For CBSE Class 9: 16-02-2024. Late Fee: Rs.100/- per week will be charged for late admissions after last date if seats are vacant.

School App: 'Noel School App' is available on Google Play Store. If parents face problem in downloading the school app, please meet along with smart mobile phone in office between 8 am and 10 am.
